<p>Please comment briefly on specific aspects of this instructor's teaching which in your opinion particularly deserve praise and criticism such as assignments, grading, testing, methods of instruction, enthusiasm, etc.:</p>
<p>Dr. Iliev has a good teaching style and explains concepts very well. He gives personal feedback on tests which is good. The out of class assignments do a good job of preparing students for evaluation and making sure they understand.</p>
<p>Good teacher who taught the subject well. One complaint that I have is he gives us suggested problems and tells us that if we know how to do them we will be prepared for the test. However, he tends to make questions not on the list that we covered for five minutes in class on the test, and they are typically 1/6 of the test.</p>
<p>He goes over the test individually using his own time, even when it is not during office hours. He is there during office hours to help any students. Willing to answer any questions and he is very knowledgeable in the subject.</p>
<p>He is an extremely intelligent man. I know a lot of people struggled in this class, but honestly nothing on the tests or quizzes or assignments was ever a surprise, and all of it was fair. Even though this class was very challenging, it was extremely rewarding. I can confidently say I've become much better at calculus after taking this course.</p>
<p>He was very knowledgeable on the subject and was always willing to sit down and go over something if you didn't understand it. Classes were set up in a good way that allowed us to cover all of the material without much confusion and there would always be some review at the beginning of most classes. However, his tests were extremely hard, even for someone who has practically taken this class before, and you could never be sure when you were going to have a quiz.</p>
<p>His lectures are hard to follow. He tends to skip around a lot in the material, and sometimes he leaves out basic information that is critical to understanding the material. He also spends too much time on theoretical information, and we rarely get to practice material that we will actually be graded on.</p>
<p>I think that Professor Iliev can be a good teacher, but he gets off topic a lot in class. He can begin class talking about something important for 5-10 minutes, then he'll spend the rest of the period discussing something that's irrelevant and won't even be tested. I found myself having to study solely from the book and teaching myself a lot of the material.</p>
